 Respondent followed me from the "B" terminal ground transportation (satellite parking pick up), onto the satellite parking bus and into the Blue Lot.
Lisa Nowak got off the bus when I got off the bus. She was
wearing a tan trenchcoat with a hood and a wig and glasses, as
well as jeans & black shoes. She followed me to my car, then
tried to open my driver's side door & beat on the window with her hands.
She then repeatedly asked me to help her and asked to use my phone.
I told her "No." She asked me to open the door & give her a ride to
the parking garage. I started the car & told her that I would send
someone to help her. She said she couldn't hear me. I opened my window
about 3" and she sprayed me with a mace or pepper spray. I threw the car in
gear & drove to the parking
garage, where we called the police.



of the corner of my eye meandering through the parking lot. I quickly cut into row 21, found my car, threw my bag in the back seat. I heard a woman's footsteps toward me so I very quickly got into my car & locked the doors. The lady in the thump coat tapped at the window with her hands & tried to open the car door. I put my keys in the ignition. She said "Can you help me please. My boyfriend was supposed to pick me up but he's not here. I've been traveling and it's late. Can you give me a ride to the parking lot?" I said, "No, if you need help I'll send someone to help you." She said, "Can't you use your phone please to call him?" I said, "No, the battery is dead." I started the car and took off. She said, "I can't hear you." She started to cry and begged me to help her.

I cracked my window open about 2" and told her I'd send someone to help her, and that she should wait there. She said, "Please help me." and then started playing something from a skinny black car into my window. I turned my head, about the window, help hold my breath & turned the car into reverse. I parked in front of her & noticed a car was parked in front of me, so I threw the car into drive and hit the gas. It moved really bad in the car so I put down the passenger front & back windows as I sped toward the parking gate. Only the E-pass tape had a green light and I don't have an E-pass. I was unsure how to get to a person to pay my parking bill & leave. I pulled up to a bus next to the parking gate & told the driver that I was just attacked by a lady in the parking lot.

"I asked him, 'How did you get out of here?' He told me to look up and pull into the E-pass lane. He said there was someone in the booth. I looked up and pulled into the E-pass lane. I told the lady at the booth that someone had attacked me & that they'd sprayed something into my car. The lady asked me where it happened. I told her 'In the car.' I gave her my parking stub & called her if she could please call the police. I started to cry a little & rubbed my eyes & my head. My eyes started to burn to the point that I couldn't keep them open. The lady in the booth gave me a couple of paper towels to dab my eyes. I told the police officer that a lady in a tan trench coat with black hair & blue jeans attacked me in room 31 and sprayed something like pepper spray into my car. (Before the police arrived, the lady in the booth had handed me the phone to talk to the call operator. When the police arrived, I gave the phone back to the lady.)

The police officer asked me to pull my car forward & out of the E-pass lane, which I did. He said he wanted me to go inside the parking lot to get out of the rain. I told him the lady had blurry, short hair & a dark coat & that had happened. He asked me to look at a lady in a tan trench coat who was on the bus & had a short cut of a brown head. I looked at her & told the officer that it definitely wasn't her. He asked me to take him through the parking lot to look at another car & the lady. I recognized her immediately as the girl who had attacked me. She had on the same jeans and black shoes and I recognized her face. She was wearing a different coat & her hair was styled

The petition for Injunction for Protection Against Domestic Violence filed under section 741.30, Florida Statutes or Repeat Violence, Dating Violence, or Sexual Violence under section 784.046, Florida Statutes, has been reviewed. This Court has jurisdiction of the parties and subject matter. A Temporary Injunction for Protection Against Domestic, Repeat or Dating or Sexual Violence, pending the hearing scheduled below, is NOT being entered at this time but an injunction may be entered after the hearing, depending on the findings made by the Court at that time.

FINDINGS

The Court finds that the facts, as stated in the Petition alone and without a hearing on the matter, do not demonstrate that Petitioner is a victim of domestic, repeat, dating or sexual violence or that Petitioner has reasonable cause to believe that he or she is in imminent danger of becoming a victim of domestic, repeat, dating or sexual violence. Therefore, there is not a sufficient factual basis upon which the court can enter a Temporary Injunction for Protection Against Domestic, Repeat, Dating or Sexual Violence prior to a hearing. A hearing is scheduled on the Petition for Injunction for Protection Against Domestic, Repeat, Dating or Sexual Violence under Notice Of Hearing in this order. Petitioner may amend or supplement the Petition at any time to state further reasons why a Temporary Injunction should be ordered which would be in effect until the hearing scheduled below.

NOTICE OF HEARING

Petitioner and Respondent are ordered to appear and testify at a hearing on the Petition for Injunction for Protection Against Domestic, Repeat, Dating or Sexual Violence on {date} FEBRUARY 20, 2007 at 8:30A.m. at {location} VIERA CT RM 2B before the Honorable MCCLUAN FOR PJB at which time the Court will consider whether a Final Judgment of Injunction for Protection Against Domestic, Repeat, Dating or Sexual Violence should be entered. If entered, the injunction will remain in effect until a fixed date set by the Court or until modified or dissolved by the Court. At the hearing, the Court will determine whether other things should be ordered, including for example, such matters as visitation and support.

If Petitioner and/or Respondent do not appear, orders may be entered, including the imposition of court costs or an injunction.


