

Interviews with 1,028 adult Americans, including 454 registered voters who describe themselves as Democrats or as Independents who lean Democratic and 414 registered voters who describe themselves as Republicans or as Independents who lean Republican, conducted by telephone by Opinion Research Corporation on May 4-6, 2007. The margin of sampling error for results based on the total sample is plus or minus 3 percentage points. For results for registered Democrats, the sampling error is plus or minus 4.5 percentage points and for registered Republicans it is plus or minus 5 percentage points.
