IN THE NAME AND BY THE AUTHORITY OF THE STATE OF FLORIDA:

The Grand Jurors of the State of Florida, duly called, impaneled and sworn to inquire and true presentment make in and for the body of the County of Miami-Dade, upon their oaths, present that on or about the 26th day of November, 2007, within the County of Miami-Dade, State of Florida, ERIC RIVERA, JR., JASON SCOTT MITCHELL, CHARLES WARDLOW, and VENJAH HUNTE, while acting as principals, did unlawfully and feloniously kill a human being, to wit: SEAN MAURICE TAYLOR, while engaged in the perpetration of, or in an attempt to perpetrate any burglary, by shooting him, and during the commission of the offense, ERIC RIVERA, JR. possessed a firearm and during the course of the commission of the offense, said ERIC RIVERA, JR. discharged a firearm and as a result of the discharge, death or great bodily harm was inflicted upon SEAN MAURICE TAYLOR, a human being, with a firearm, and while committing the offense, JASON SCOTT MITCHELL was wearing a hood or mask or other device to conceal his identity, in violation of s. 782.04(1), s. 775.087, s. 775.0845 and s. 777.011, Florida Statutes, to the evil example of all others in like cases offending and against the peace and dignity of the State of Florida.

COUNT II

The Grand Jurors of the State of Florida, duly called, impaneled and sworn to inquire and true presentment make in and for the body of the County of Miami-Dade, upon their oaths, present that on or about the 26th day of November, 2007, within the County of Miami-Dade, State of Florida, ERIC RIVERA, JR., JASON SCOTT MITCHELL, CHARLES WARDLOW, and VENJAH HUNTE, while acting as principals, did unlawfully enter or remain in a dwelling located at 18650 Old Cutler Road, Miami-Dade County, Florida, the property of SEAN MAURICE TAYLOR,

without the consent of SEAN MAURICE TAYLOR, as owner or custodian, the same being occupied by SEAN MAURICE TAYLOR and/or JACQUELINE GARCIA; the defendants having an intent to commit an offense therein, to wit: Theft, and in the course of committing said burglary, the defendant made an assault or battery upon SEAN MAURICE TAYLOR, by shooting SEAN MAURICE TAYLOR, and ERIC RIVERA, JR. possessed a firearm and during the course of the commission of the offense, said defendant, ERIC RIVERA, JR. discharged a firearm and as a result of the discharge, death or great bodily harm was inflicted on SEAN MAURICE TAYLOR, a human being, and while committing the offense, JASON SCOTT MITCHELL was wearing a hood or mask or other device to conceal his identity in violation of s. 810.02(2)(a), s. 775.0845, s. 775.087 and s. 777.011 Florida Statutes, contrary to the form of the statute in such cases made and provided, and against the peace and dignity of the State of Florida.
